## Title

The title of the article should be in 14 font size, lower-case (except first letter of first word and any proper names), Times New Roman. Words like *in vitro*, and Latin names of plants should be in italics.

List all authors' names with initials before surname (e.g. Manjeet Singh, K. K. Yadav, V. Kumar and S. R. Bhakar). Not bold. One author will need to be identified as the corresponding author using a superscript asterisk (\*) in the authorship line. Give full postal address (es) in upper- and lower-case. Not bold. If more than one address, indicate each appropriate author by superscripts 1, 2, etc. If an author's current address differs from that at the head of the paper, give present address as a footnote with a superscript number next to his/her name. Include e mail address of corresponding author.

## ABSTRACT

Left-justify, ABSTRACT in capitals, 12 font size. Start text leaving 1 line space. Text should be Justify, present as a single paragraph, normally not longer than 250 words, 12 font size. Do not repeat the title of the paper. ABSTRACT should not contain any citations or abbreviations (unless used more than once, then define in full at first use). Include information about the purpose of the work, how it was done, the main findings and their relevance.

## Key Words

Maximum 6 key words, *italic*, in alphabetical order

## MAIN TEXT

Divided into the main headings:

### **INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSIONS and REFERENCES**

Only three types of Headings and sub-headings (left-justified) sufficient, follow the hierarchy: (i) **CAPITALS** (12 font size, UPPER CASE, bold) with text on next line no indent (12 font size no bold); (ii) **Sub Heading** (12 font size, bold, **Title Case** letter) with text on next line, no indented; (iii) italic *sub-sub-heading* (12 font size, no bold), followed by a colon, with text on same line. Leave one line space between text and next (sub-) heading.

### **Authors' statement of any conflicts of interest and acknowledgement of sources of funding**

Authors' statement of any conflicts of interest and acknowledgement of sources of funding for the research if necessary (heading; bold, title case, 12 font size) follow after the end of the main text, leaving only one extra line.

## REFERENCES

Refer to the authors and year of publication within the text as follows. (Singh, 2000); (Urmila and Singh, 2010) and in case of three or more authors (Yadav *et al.*, 2000). When two or

more references are to be cited together, they should be given in the chronological order (Kumar,1990; Singh, 2000).

All references cited in the text should be presented in the list of **REFERENCES** as following guide lines.

References should be indicated in the typescript using the Harvard style referencing giving the author's name, and year of publication in parentheses. If several papers by the same author and from the same year are cited a, b, c, etc. should put after the year of publication. Justify. Check references against original sources, paying particular attention to correct full article and journal titles, spellings, accents etc, especially in languages other than English. Include DOIs for references. The references should be listed in full at the end of the paper in the following standard form:
